

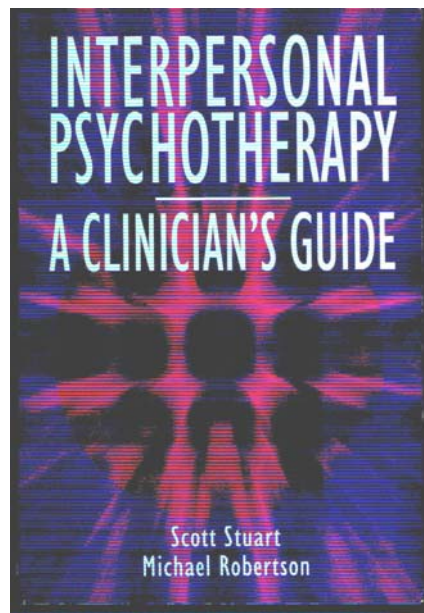
Interpersonal Psychotherapy Workshop With Dr Michael Robertson

A 3-day workshop

IPT is an empirically valid psychotherapy that primarily draws on attachment theory. Despite its credentials, it remains at the margins of clinical practice. This introductory course will outline the basics of IPT and encourage you to consider how it may be useful in your clinical practice. The course will focus on the theory and clinical application of IPT, the structure of IPT, assessments, patient selection, interpersonal inventory & formulation, IPT techniques, and problem area including interpersonal disputes, role transition, grief & loss and interpersonal sensitivity, amongst other important aspects of basic IPT. This course will help you get started on using IPT effectively in your clinical practice.
