PROF MALCOLM HOPWOOD

Prof Malcolm Hopwood is currently the Ramsay Health Care Professor of Psychiatry, University of Melbourne; based at Ramsay Clinic Albert Road. At Ramsay Clinic Albert Road, he provides inpatient care within the Professorial Psychiatry Unit as well as outpatient consultations focused on second psychiatric opinions.

Prof Hopwood has a long track record of involvement in psychiatric research. His research areas of interest include clinical aspects of mood and anxiety disorders, psychopharmacology and psychiatric aspects of acquired brain injury. He also leads the undergraduate and registrar training schemes at the Ramsay Clinic Albert Road.

Prof Hopwood was President of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Psychiatrists from 2015 to 2017. He was also co-chair of Equally Well Australia from 2018 to 2022. He is now President of the Asian Federation of Psychiatric Associations and in 2017 was made an Honorary Member of the World Psychiatric Association.
